- **Baxter**

- Community & Board Member concerns about gaining schools' ability to receive all students from Baxter; the plan will work

- **Fire Lake**

- Recommendations to change boundaries and/or close programs at Birchwood & Eagle River elementary schools in order to increase enrollment at Fire Lake
- Potential for new housing at Powder Ridge, across the highway from Fire Lake, and across from Fire Lake
- Concerns with increased traffic at Eagle River Elementary School



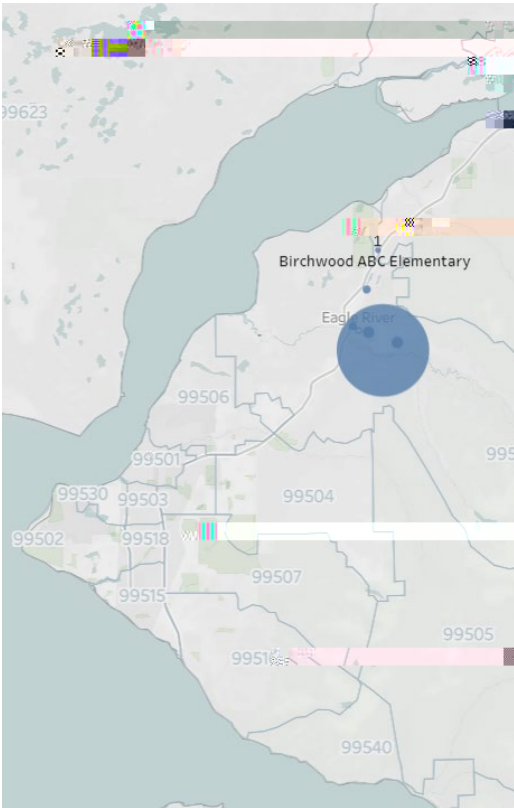
# Current Year Enrollment in ASD Schools

  - 42,488 students enrolled
  - 14,494 students transferred out of their school boundary into a different school (34%)
    - 2,752 charter school students
    - 4,330 alternative school students
    - 2,717 immersion students

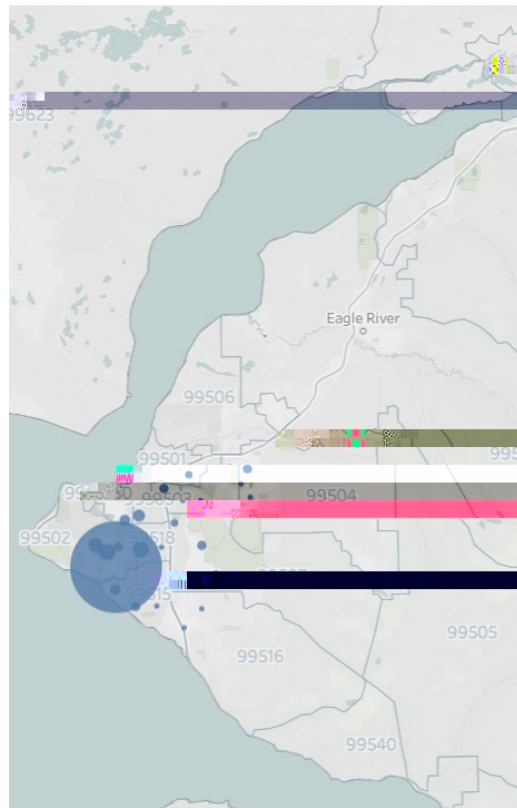

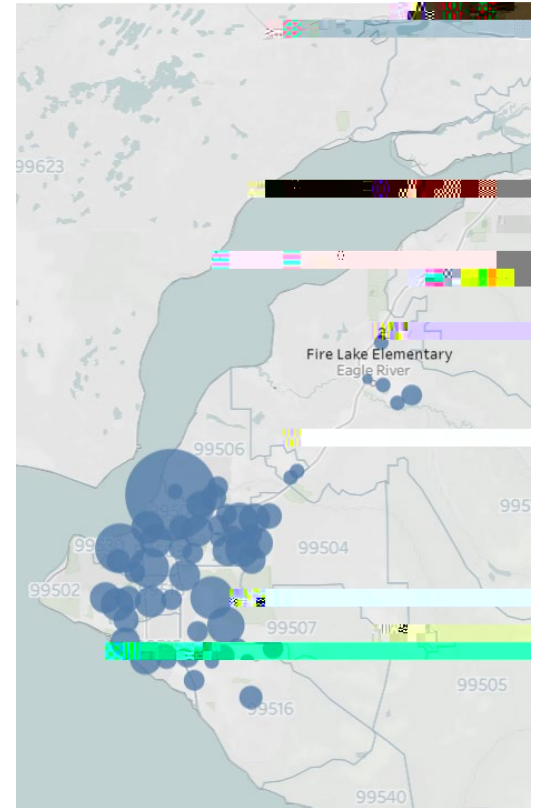
